Day 1: Saturday, December 4, 2027 Overnight Flight

Set out on a holiday adventure through the iconic capital cities of Central Europe – Prague, Vienna, and Budapest. Along the way, immerse yourself in festive Christmas markets, enjoy traditional entertainment, sample local cuisine, and glimpse this region's rich history.

Day 2: Sunday, December 5, 2027 Prague, Czech Republic

Ancient landmarks and medieval architecture – you've arrived in Prague, the "City of 100 Spires." With no scheduled activities today, spend your time as you wish, exploring the city independently. This evening, gather with your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner at a local restaurant. (D)

Day 3: Monday, December 6, 2027 Prague

Experience the magic and wonder of Prague during the holiday season. Your introduction to this fairy-tale city begins with a panoramic tour. Explore the "Castle District," including the gothic St. Vitus Cathedral and the majestic Prague Castle. Marvel at the iconic, statue-lined Charles Bridge, a picturesque structure stretching over the Vltava River. Spend the rest of the day taking in the best Prague has to offer independently. Visit the renowned Christmas market in Old Town Square filled with artisan crafts, festive food, and warm holiday drinks. (B)

Day 4: Tuesday, December 7, 2027 Prague - Dresden, Germany - Prague

Travel to Dresden, Germany, known as "Florence on the Elbe." Join a local guide for a tour highlighting its Baroque architecture, including Frauenkirche (Church of Our Lady) and the Royal Palace. Visit the Striezelmarkt, the world's oldest Christmas market, dating back to 1434. Enjoy free time exploring the stalls overflowing with ornaments, sample local sweets, and get lunch on your own before returning to Prague later in the afternoon. (B)

Day 5: Wednesday, December 8, 2027 Prague - Český Krumlov - Vienna, Austria

Depart Prague and travel through the scenic countryside toward Vienna, Austria. En route, stop in the medieval town of Český Krumlov. Explore its charming cobblestone streets and impressive castle independently, with time for lunch on your own. Continue onward to Vienna, where you'll enjoy dinner at a traditional Viennese restaurant known for its historic ambiance and classic Austrian cuisine. Arrive in the grand city of Vienna, aglow with holiday lights. Perhaps you'll join your Tour Manager for an evening stroll. (B, D)

Day 6: Thursday, December 9, 2027 Vienna

This morning, meet your local guide for a combined scenic bus and walking tour of Vienna's city center, showcasing grand architecture, scenic parks, and Gothic spires that fill the city. Get a taste of Vienna's sweet confectionary history when you visit a family-owned candy workshop. See where candies are still being made according to traditional recipes dating back over 150 years. Enjoy free time in the afternoon to visit the Christkindlmarkt. Perhaps the biggest and most famous in the city, it is set at the neo-gothic

Rathaus City Hall. Tonight, you may choose an option to explore the Christmas market and the interiors at the magnificent Schönbrunn Palace, together with a classical music performance at the famous Orangery. (B)

Day 7: Friday, December 10, 2027 Vienna - Bratislava, Slovakia - Budapest, Hungary Travel to Bratislava, the former Imperial capital of the Habsburg Empire. Enjoy free time for lunch, exploring historic streets, and visiting charming Christmas markets. Continue into the Hungarian countryside for a cultural experience at a rustic local restaurant. Learn how to make traditional Hungarian strudel before indulging in typical Hungarian fare for dinner. Later this evening, arrive in Budapest, the "Queen of the Danube," and your home for the next two nights. Enjoy the evening on your own or join your Tour Manager for an evening walk. (B, D)

Day 8: Saturday, December 11, 2027 Budapest This morning, choose how you want to experience Budapest with an expert local guide because **it's your choice!** Embark on a classic Budapest city tour, where you'll visit highlights like the Fisherman's Bastion and pass the historic Old Buda **-OR-** retrace Budapest's musical history throughout the city before visiting The House of Music Hungary. Enjoy free time this afternoon to explore Budapest's Christmas markets, St. Stephen's Basilica, or Vörösmarty Square, brimming with food and crafts stalls where local musicians often perform. This evening, celebrate the journey with your fellow travelers at a farewell dinner. (B, D)

Day 9: Sunday, December 12, 2027 Budapest - Tour Ends Say goodbye to these regal cities as your spirited holiday tour wraps up today. (B)

Important Tour Information:

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

Sightseeing often takes place outdoors in winter conditions, which may include cold temperatures, rain, snow, or icy walks.

While visiting historic areas of Prague, Cesky Krumlov, Vienna, Bratislava, and Budapest you will walk along cobblestone and uneven streets, steps, and narrow passageways.

Some of the most unique sightseeing sites can mean accessing locations that restrict motor coaches. Your coach will be parked in a designated area requiring a walk on cobblestones while exploring the historic areas.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at the time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

You will be traveling during the heart of a European winter. Expect cold temperatures, likely between 23°F to 41°F, with potential for rain, snow, and icy conditions. Proper footwear and layered clothing are essential for your comfort and safety. Market visits are primarily outdoor experiences and subject to winter weather conditions.

In Prague, you can expect up to four-and-a-half hours of walking, with stops, during the city tour. You should be prepared for climbing up and down occasional steps and walking on uneven surfaces. The Prague Castle visit lasts approximately three hours and includes standing for longer periods of time. If you have chosen the classic Budapest city tour option as your selected Choice on Tour, it will include up to three-and-a-half hours of walking.

Most of the cities on this program are very busy with visitors during Advent.

This tour features multiple long transfers exceeding two hours, in particular the transfer to and from Dresden, Germany.

The transfer from Prague to Vienna, Austria, with a stop in Český Krumlov for independent exploration, can take up to 10 hours.

The transfer from Vienna to Budapest, with stops in Bratislava and for an included dinner in the Hungarian countryside, can take up to 10 hours.

Christmas markets are seasonal and typically operate from late November through December. Specific opening dates, operating hours, and market locations vary by city and are subject to change.

Due to annual fluctuations in the opening dates of some Christmas markets and tour scheduling, if one is unavailable on a specific departure, other regional Christmas markets may be substituted.

Hotel check-in on your day of arrival is 3:00 p.m. Rooms may not be available prior to that time.

Hotels may be located outside historic centers. Access to sightseeing areas may require public transportation or walking.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

Not all major sites can be reached by coach. Public transportation might be used during the Budapest city tour.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Prepaid tipping is not available on our tours therefore payment of customary end-of-trip gratuities for your Tour Manager, driver, hotel housekeepers, and cruise ship waitstaff should be handled individually when applicable during the course of your tour.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.

Travel Requirements:

Passports are required for this tour at your expense. Certain countries require that your passport be valid at least 6 months beyond the dates of your travel. You are strongly urged to contact the appropriate consulate for details. Visit www.travel.state.gov for the U.S. State Department's latest details about passports and visa requirements.

IMPORTANT: We recommend that travelers take a photocopy of their passport and applicable visas. It should be packed separately from your actual passport and visa. We also recommend leaving a copy at home with your emergency contact.

Collette will provide all necessary information, updates, and supporting documents for your travel requirements, including visa and Electronic Travel Authorizations (ETAs), if required, approximately 60-90 days prior to your departure.

While visas are not required for U.S., Australian, New Zealand, UK, or Canadian citizens for a stay of up to 90 days, we recommend you inquire with your consulate for further information. Visitors are required to show proof of travel medical insurance to travel to the Czech Republic. The health insurance must cover medical services abroad with specific coverages. Please visit <https://travel.state.gov> (the U.S. State Department) for the latest details with regards to entry requirements. If you have **purchased our Travel Protection Plan**, your coverage meets this requirement.
